These are Florida State's and Delta Lambda's future political, athletic, academic and social leaders. Due to Covid protocols, IFC Spring rush was conducted virtually (if you can imagine that). Our Pike class is somewhat smaller than other large fraternities, but **SMC Luke Vari '18** and Rush Chairman **James Bencivenga '20** determined that Pike would not pledge any man they had not met and spoken with face-to-face. Alumni leaders agree. Most of our

contact with rushees took place before rush officially began. Chapter leadership deserves much credit for insisting on quality first.

In other Chapter news, since the university will not allow intramurals (or parties, or events), Pike Stickball has become, as **IVP Max Roix '18** reports "Wildly popular". So involved are the nearly 200 undergraduate members that the Chapter appoints a Board of 'Stickball Commissioners' to oversee the competition.

SMC Luke Vari '18 said that four Pikes are candidates for 'Men of the Year' at Delta Gamma, Kappa Delta, Tri-Delt and ADPi. You'd expect nothing less. However, the University has changed the rules; the annual award is no longer based entirely on popularity, but also requires contributions to the individual sororities' charities.

The Brothers have a Paintball Day coming up, and Dads' Day is scheduled for the day of the spring game, April 10. Student Government will host a 'Military Ball' on March 19, with Delta Lambda alum **Major Patrick Sullivan '01** as the guest speaker. Despite the awful restrictions, **ThC Jack Williams '19** reports that "the collection rate is very high."

Chapter Advisor **John Peacock '01** says he believes "things are opening up...sort of". It's never a good bet to predict what the university is going to do. We're pleased to see one of our old rivals, Sigma Chi, returning to colonize at FSU this fall. Welcome back Sigs! Ex-Tampa, FSU players cheer win

Even as Barry Smith watched the trophy presentation from the 700 level in the end zone at Lambeau Field Sunday, he couldn't believe his eyes.

But it was true.

Quarterback Tom Brady and the Tampa Bay Buccaneers knocked off the No. 1-seeded Green Bay Packers 31-26 in the NFC Championship Game to advance to Super Bowl LV on Sunday, Feb. 7 in Tampa.

The Bucs will face the defending Super Bowl champion Kansas City Chiefs, a 38-24 winner over the visiting Buffalo Bills in Sunday's AFC Championship Game. The Chiefs beat the Bucs 27-24 in Tampa earlier this season in Week 12.

"It is so surreal, so incredible," said Smith, the former Florida State receiver who played three seasons with the


After being named First Team All-American by every collegiate ranking service, Delta Lambda Pike **Daniel Berger '12** left FSU as a sophomore and went straight to the PGA; he was PGA Rookie of the Year in 2015.

From USA Today, February 14, 2021: "On Sunday in the final round, Berger, needing a birdie to win or a par to force a playoff, split the fairway with a 276-yard drive on the 18th, knocked his approach from 250 yards onto the green with a 3-wood, slammed the door on the tournament by sinking a 30-foot putt for eagle and left the grounds with the championship hardware. Berger, now 13th in the official world ranking, won his fourth PGA Tour title.

Gary Prescott '72 was pledged into the spring class of 1972. Gary joined on the cusp of the most dramatic surge of domination in Delta Lambda's history. Wilson B. Heller,

founder of the College Survey Bureau, told our Chapter Advisor **Ed Cubbon '29** that by 1973, Pike was "not only the #1 ranked fraternity at FSU; Delta Lambda was also ranked further ahead of their nearest rivals than any other #1 ranked chapter of any fraternity in the nation!" It was an amazing time to be a Pike at FSU."

"Yes," Gary writes, "1972 was long ago, but I still vividly remember the Rush Chairman offering to pledge me in Fall 1971. It was Pikes versus Lambda Chi on the intramural field. At the time, I didn't understand the significance of my acceptance. My Pike Brothers have played a large part in my daily life since my Spring '72 initiation.

"I know there are many other brothers that have similar stories where Pike has been involved in shaping their future. I've said it in the past and say it again.

"In some degree, my life has been shaped and enriched by the life-long friendships I made through Delta Lambda. I want the current generation of Pikes to have that same opportunity, and that's why I'll consider more specific gifts to our fraternity."
