





The Seminoles flew across the country for a pair of games, starting with No. 8 Arizona State in Tempe on Friday night. Thanks to 17 saves by Cicio, Florida

State was able to grind out a 6-5 victory. The following evening in Tucson, Cicio turned away another 14 shots as FSU posted a 9-7 triumph against Arizona. For the weekend, Cicio notched a 72.1 save percentage along with a 6.00 goals against average in what were his first two collegiate starts.

"Seven Years Ago Today ... March 6, 2010, DELTA LAMBDA DESCENDS UPON DUVAL. It was during the chapter's first-ever ALUMNI WEEKEND that Key West was formally introduced to the Florida State Pikes. Highlighted by a six-hour "Duval Crawl" on Saturday afternoon, the long weekend brought together twenty-nine agedenying revelers from around the country, each anxious to relive a few fond memories from a simpler time. Gathering at the Southernmost Point of the United States (pictured), the group launched into one of the most yarn-generating Weekend adventures since Dave Markowski kidnapped the hotel clerk's parrot and led the entire St. Augustine Police Dept. on a midnight pursuit across the dunes of Anastasia Island. Together, the island-happy brothers slogged, stumbled, staggered and sang their way along Duval St., all the way across the breadth of Old Town Key West. The rag-tag group stopped occasionally to sample the house specialties at a dozen or so pubs, including the upper deck at Fogarty's -- a platform from which several members of the Delta Lambda contingent stood on their chairs and hit favorite bodybuilding poses while crowing to no one in particular about their dominance over all they surveyed, much to the chagrin of Fogarty's patrons in the courtyard below. The scene was somewhat reminiscent of the old Pike Deck at Big Daddy's on "Beat The Clock" night some thirty years prior, except it was Jimmy Buffett looking down on the crowd instead of John Travolta! wink emoticon;-) Eventually, the group found its way to Mallory Square in time to join the island's legendary sunset celebration; twenty-nine happy bubbas basking in the golden glow of the Gulf Coast radiance. Then on to a group dinner followed by a late-night takeover of Irish Kevin's, featuring a series of bawdy limericks and strawberry Jello shots served by an exceedingly hot Russian waitress named Anna. The event ultimately inspired a follow-up adventure in 2015. And who knows, maybe there's another Alumni Weekend in paradise yet to come? In the meantime, the wonderful memories of brothers living large in Key West continues to warm the hearts and brighten the smiles of all who attended ... seven years ago today!


