Chapter Advisor Jimmy Keen '73 arranged for nationally renowned pain management physician Dr. Bert Chandler '76 to speak to the Chapter about drug addiction and the opioid crisis. "At first the chapter was a little hesitant," said Keen. "They expressed concerns that a publicized presentation might give the impression that we have a drug problem. Delta Lambda has no such problem at present, and

we want to continue to ensure that we have no problems going forward. This is why we place such extreme emphasis on Risk Management education."

The response from Westcott was immediate and dramatic. University President Thrasher accepted Keen's and Dr. Chandler's invitation to attend, and brought along his Vice President and Director of Greek Life as well. Thrasher spoke to the Chapter about his vision for a safe campus for Florida State students and the reasons he took the extreme steps he did last fall.

In the fall, Austin's younger brother Cannon was pledged and initiated, and in March, Austin's parents Brent and Sharon Ekern were special guests of the Chapter.

Chapter Advisor Jimmy Keen '73 said, "They were most gracious for the stellar event; the chapter worked hard and executed with excellence. I spent some time with the Ekerns and they were extremely grateful."

On May 20th, the Atlantic Coast Conference announced five Seminoles had been named to the All-ACC Baseball team. Four of these are Delta Lambda Pikes!



Next Alumni Luncheon: Wednesday, June 6th, 2018 @ 12:00 noon.


